GUIDELINES

LIFE grants are available for educational and youth projects serving LaGrange County. Public and private schools seeking support for classroom or extracurricular activities must apply for funding through LIFE.

WHO CAN APPLY

- Non-profit organizations
- Government agencies
- Public schools

Are all eligible to apply for grants from LIFE in support of specific charitable projects that serve youth; are readily accessible to the general public, and are non-political and non-denominational in their purposes.

- Arts & Culture
- Community Development
- Education
- Environment
- Health & Human Services
- Recreation
- **Priority Focus: After School Youth Programming**

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

LIFE encourages projects that do the following:

- Promote cooperation and avoid duplication
- Inspire and encourage additional funding
- Request seed money for exciting and innovative ways to meet unmet youth needs
- Reach a broad segment of the youth community
- Provide youth services that are normally not provided

REQUIREMENTS

EACH APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE A PROJECT BUDGET WITH EXPECTED REVENUE & EXPENSES.

All grant recipients are required to submit a final grant report within 30 days of the project completion date.

HOW TO APPLY

- Apply online at lccf.net

LIFE grant applications will be accepted twice a year.

LIFE grant deadlines

- October 1, 2022
 - Notification November 2022
- January 1, 2023
 - Notification February 2023

Youth-serving organizations are encouraged but not required to make their requests through LIFE.

Grant amounts typically range from \$250 to \$2,500 and are reviewed by the Foundation's youth philanthropy group, LIFE.
