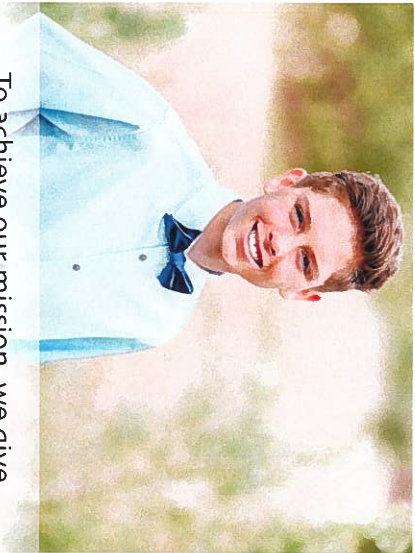

To achieve our mission, we give presentations at local high schools and teen organizations. We make the issue personal, giving teens and young adults a first hand account of the consequences that can come from drug use.

Our message is about the dangers of drug use in general, and how fentanyl has made it so much more dangerous in this era. Every type of drug on the street is being laced with fentanyl, and only 2mg of fentanyl is enough to kill someone. We also focus on the role social media plays, highlighting how it has increased the availability and distribution of various drugs to people, especially teenagers.

In order to reach young adults more effectively, we have received certifications and training in the programs we offer. We believe that with God all things are possible, and the organization and those within it are driven to see this big vision succeed. Lake may not be here to warn our teenagers about the dangers of drug use, but through his legacy he will save lives.

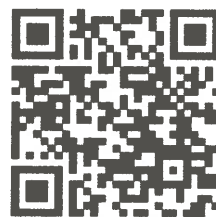

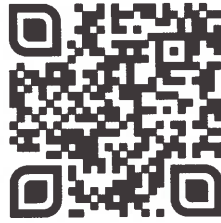
